

Essential Questions:


Can I identify different people who help us?

Cheeko the Sheriff of Nuttingham

Now we will listen to a story called 'Cheeko the Sheriff of Nuttingham'. This is Cheeko! Click on the picture to begin listening:


After listening to the story, Cheeko the Sherriff of Nuttingham, ask the children who Cheeko was helping at the beginning of the story? Who was he helping by the end?

Ask children to think about all the people who help them? They may suggest their parents, grandparents, siblings. Ask them to explain why and how they help.

Challenge the children to then think of jobs people do that help others and make a list as a class of jobs that help people - doctors, police, fireman etc.

The teacher may want to download a selection of images of these professions and share these onto the children's devices. This will give you a chance to challenge gender stereotypes with certain jobs - male nurse, female police officer.

Ask the children to open the app 'Shadow Puppets Edu' and tap the + button to start a new project.



Either select the images of professions or use the image search to select a series of images and examples of people who help us.

Tap next towards the bottom right corner which will take you to the recording screen.

Children can now tap the start button where they get a three-second countdown and record themselves talking through the job and how that profession helps us. Once finished they can tap pause.

If you need to re-record, you can tap undo in the bottom left corner that will allow you to re-record that slide.

If happy with the recording, tap the arrow to the next slide and repeat the process with each picture giving children the opportunity to share their knowledge and understanding about people who help us.

At the end, tap done and the app will save it as a video for you to share.





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
