







Make Your Own Patience Mini Book




Step 1: With the images facing down, fold the book template in half, lengthwise.




Step 2: Now, fold each side in toward the middle crease.




Step 3: Unfold and lay the paper flat and facedown, then fold it down the middle on the short side.




Step 4: Now fold the sides in toward the new middle crease.




Step 5: Unfold and lay your paper flat again. Carefully cut along the three cut lines, starting at the scissor symbol and stopping when you reach the X. This will create a zigzag.



Step 6: With the front and back covers facing you, fold page 1 behind the front cover and page 2 into page 1, like an accordion.



Step 7: Fold page 3 down behind page two, then continue folding in a zigzag accordion pattern.




Step 8: Cut off the final page, then glue the back cover (Moshi logo) to the last page.






